## **GENERAL GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES**

1. Open visitation, with preferred hours 10:30 am – 8:00 pm.
2. Patients may have TWO (2) visitors. We prefer and recommend no children under the age of 12 are permitted.
3. Visitors in the facility, in certain circumstances, may be asked to wear a mask, maintain social distancing, and stay in the patient room where they are visiting, unless going to the cafeteria.

### **Emergency Department**

- Two (2) visitors (over the age of 18) with each patient arrival to the ED.
- Visitors may accompany patient and remain in the room during ED stay. Certain times may require (1) visitor.
- End of Life exceptions will be made.
- Exceptions will be made if patient is a parent and a child/children present.

### **Acute Care/Transitional Care/Swing Bed**

- Two (2) visitors (over the age of 12 preferred) are allowed at the bedside. Visitors may switch out to maintain the (2) visitor policy.
- End of Life exceptions will be made.

### **Rehabilitation**

- Two (2) adults

### **Outpatient Services**

- Two (2) adults

### **Mansfield Place**

- Although visitation is now permitted, visits should be conducted in a manner that adheres to the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention and does not increase risk to other residents:
  - No visitation should occur if the visitor has recently had a positive COVID-19 test, currently has symptoms of COVID-19, or is under quarantine or work exclusion.
  - Visitors should wear masks/face coverings when around residents or healthcare personnel. Visitors should also physically distance from others.
  - If Resident is COVID POSITIVE, visitation will take place in the resident's room.
